Planning Commission

5 Members
Four Year Term

Description

The Planning Commission shall have all powers and duties imposed upon a planning commission and zoning agency by the Planning and Zoning Law of the State, subject to the provisions of the City Municipal Code, and shall act as the advisory agency pursuant to the Subdivision Map Act of the State. In addition, the Planning Commission shall consider the overall architectural development, including color and material of exteriors, of all commercial and industrial districts and all developments in residential districts for which a use permit or architectural review permit is required. The Commission also plays a role in the administration of the City Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Ordinance. The Commission reviews and acts upon the following: 1) General Plan and General Plan amendments; 2) Neighborhood and specific area plans; 3) Environmental impact reports and negative declarations; 4) Tentative subdivision maps; 5) Planned Development permit applications for developments; 6) Subdivision Ordinance exceptions; 7) Zoning and Subdivision Ordinance amendments; 8) Special studies and reports; and 9) Architectural Reviews and Use Permits for various properties.

Membership

There is established in the city a planning commission to consist of five residents of the city, each of whom has continuously resided in the city for a period of at least three years immediately prior to submission of an application for appointment to the planning commission. All applicants shall be over the age of eighteen years, one of whom should, if practical, be a licensed architect. All members of the planning commission shall be eligible for reappointment to one successive four-year term. No member may serve for more than two four-year terms in succession. Members shall be appointed by the Mayor upon the recommendation and approval of the City Council to terms of four years each. Members are compensated \$269.00 per month.

Description

The Traffic Review Committee shall only make advisory recommendations to the City Council. It shall be the duty of the Traffic Review Committee to receive and review appeals or requests from citizens or staff regarding traffic matters and to make recommendations to the City Council. The Committee shall meet at the call of the Chair, at such time and place as may be appropriate, in order to receive and hear as much information as possible pertaining to the matters to be discussed.

Membership

The Committee consists of the Director of Public Works or his designated representative, the Chief of Police or his designated representative, the Fire Chief or his designated representative, a member of the Planning Commission, the City Engineer (or City Traffic Engineer), the Community Development Director, and a resident of the City appointed by the Mayor. Members serve without compensation.
