

## CITY OF FOSTER CITY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Foster City will hold a Public Hearing on April 2, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. to consider the following:

(1) A RECOMMENDATION TO CITY COUNCIL FOR AN INITIAL STUDY/NEGATIVE DECLARATION WHICH IDENTIFIES AND DISCUSSES THE POTENTIAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS OF THE PROJECT (EA-14-008); (2) A RECOMMENDATION TO CITY COUNCIL FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE VINTAGE PARK GENERAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN TO ALLOW UP TO ± 15,348 SQ. FT. OF RESTAURANT SPACE AND, ± 6,455 SQ. FT. OF FAST CASUAL DINING OR RETAIL SPACE, INSTEAD OF ±18,994 SQ. FT. OF RESTAURANT SPACE (RZ-14-003); AND (3) A SPECIFIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN/USE PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A 11,830 SQUARE FOOT RESTAURANT AND RETAIL BUILDING (UP-14-009) AT 1297 CHESS DRIVE – VINTAGE PARK NEIGHBORHOOD – APN: 094-901-350 – FULLWEL INTERNATIONAL GROUP INC
