
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Foster City will hold a Study Session on May 7, 2015, immediately following the Regular Meeting which begins at 7:00 p.m. to consider the following:

TO REVIEW REVISED ARCHITECTURE AND DESIGN, INCLUDING BUILDING AND PARKING STRUCTURE HEIGHTS, BUILDING GROSS SQUARE FOOTAGE, AND HARDSCAPE DESIGN FOR THREE OFFICE/LAB BUILDINGS AND AN AMENITIES BUILDING TOTALING 595,000 SQUARE FEET AND THREE PARKING GARAGES WITH 1,793 PARKING SPACES ON THE PROPOSED + 20-ACRE PORTION OF THE LINCOLN CENTRE CAMPUS – BMR LINCOLN CENTRE LP – 200-850 LINCOLN CENTRE DRIVE – NEIGHBORHOOD L – APNs: 094-532-170; 180; 190; 200; 250 – UP-15-002
