NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Foster City will hold a Special Meeting at **6:30 pm** on **Monday, October 13, 2014** to discuss the proposed redevelopment of the existing $\pm 115,000$ square foot Edgewater Place Shopping Center to a mixed-use development including $\pm 59,000$ square feet of retail space and ± 150 residences, including townhouses and flats, on Edgewater Blvd, between Beach Park Blvd. and Port Royal Ave. – 901-999 Edgewater Blvd. - Neighborhood 8 – APN: 094-541-070 – PR-14-001

PURPOSE

The purposes of this development project preliminary review meeting are:

- To introduce the proposed project concept to the City Council and the public;
- To give the City Council and the neighborhood's residents an opportunity to provide feedback on the project during the conceptual stage;
- To give the neighborhood a very early opportunity to become a part of the planning and design review process;
