ARTICLE 1 INVITATION TO BID

- 1.01 Notice Inviting Bids:** Owner will receive sealed Bids at the City Clerk's Office, located at 610 Foster City Boulevard, Foster City, California 94404 until 2:00 PM on Tuesday, January 26, 2016 for the following public work:

- 1.02 Project Description:** CIP 301-650 improves the playground site as well as a synthetic turf surface at the beach area and a pour in place resilient surfacing for the playground area. Also included in the project will be the construction of a small picnic area. The scope of work includes removal and preservation of playground support posts. Demolition of softscape, sand beach, playground pit, and hardscape paving. Contractor to complete: earthwork grading, drainage, installation of concrete edgeband, retaining wall, guard rail, site utilities and placement / installation of site furnishings. Contractor shall coordinate all work with the City's representative. Work shall be completed within 90 Calendar Days from the date when Contract Time commences to run.
- 1.03 Procurement of Bidding Documents:** Bidding Documents contain the full description of the Work. Bidders may examine a complete hard-copy set of the Bidding Documents at the City's Parks Department, located at 100 Lincoln Centre Drive, Foster City, California 94404.

- Bidding Documents need not be returned to City. Bidder is responsible for printing any and all of Bidding Documents.
- 1.04 Instructions:** Bidders shall refer to Document 00 2113 (Instructions to Bidders) for required documents and items to be submitted in a sealed envelope for deposit into the Bid Box in the City Clerk's Office, located at 610 Foster City Boulevard, Foster City, California 94404 no later than the time and date set forth in Paragraph 1.01 above.
- 1.05 Pre-Bid Conference:** Owner will conduct a Pre-Bid Conference at 10:00 AM on Wednesday January 13, 2016 at 100 Lincoln Centre Drive, Foster City, California 94404. The Pre-Bid Conference will last approximately **one** hour.
- 1.06 Bid Preparation Cost:** Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their Bids.
- 1.07 Reservation of Rights:** Owner specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all Bids, to re-bid, or to waive inconsequential defects in bidding not involving time, price or quality of the work. Owner may reject any and all Bids and waive any minor irregularities in the Bids.
- 1.08 Portion of Work to be Performed by Contractor:** The successful bidder shall self-perform no less than **25%** of the Work described in the Contract Documents utilizing its own work force, excluding Specialty Items. Specialty Items will be identified in the Contract Documents.

ARTICLE 2 LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

2.01 Required Contractor's License(s): A California "A" contractor's license is required to bid this contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract. Specialty work may require a specialty contractor's license "C" held by Bidder or a listed subcontractor.

2.02 Required Contractor and Subcontractor Registration

- A. Owner shall accept Bids only from Bidders that (along with all Subcontractors listed in Document 00 4330, Subcontractor List) are currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.
- B. Subject to Labor Code Sections 1771.1(c) and (d), any Bid not complying with paragraph 2.02A above shall be returned and not considered; provided that if Bidder is a joint venture (Business & Professions Code Section 7029.1) or if federal funds are involved in the Contract (Labor Code Section 1771.1(a)), Owner may accept a non-complying Bid provided that Bidder and all listed Subcontractors are registered at the time of Contract award.

2.03 Bid Alternates:

- A. There are no bid alternatives for this project.
- B. The determination of lowest bid shall be based upon:
 - 1. Base contract bid only;

2.04 Non-Substitutable Materials, Products, Things, or Services


- A. Non-substitutable items are identified as follows:
 - 1. Site furnishings as listed in section 02870
 - 2. Refer to specifications for synthetic turf.
 - 3. Refer to specifications for pour in place attenuation.
- B. Owner has made a finding that the material(s), product(s), thing(s), or service(s) identified above by specific brand or trade name are required for use in the Project and may not be substituted for "or equal" items, for the following purpose(s):
 - 1. In order to match other products in use on a particular Owner project either completed or in the course of completion.

2.05 Substitution of Securities: Owner will permit the successful bidder to substitute securities for any retention monies withheld to ensure performance of the contract, as set forth in Document 00 6290 Escrow Agreement For Security Deposits In Lieu Of Retention and incorporated herein in full by this reference, in accordance with Section 22300 of the California Public Contract Code.

2.06 Prevailing Wage Laws: The successful Bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents. Copies of the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute the Contract, as determined by Director of the State of California Department of Industrial Relations, are on file at the City's Public Works Department, may be obtained from the California Department of Industrial Relations website [<http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/DPreWageDetermination.htm>] and are deemed included in the Bidding Documents. Upon request, Owner will make available copies to any interested party. Also, the successful Bidder shall post the applicable prevailing wage rates at the Site.

2.07 Prevailing Wage Monitoring: This Project is subject to prevailing wage compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
