PROGRAM DETAILS & UPCOMING CAMP

During the Wednesday Afterschool Enrichment Program, we ask that parents follow a few guidelines and communicate a few reminders to their child to make this a successful program:

1. Register *early!* To avoid cancellation of classes for your child and to guarantee the class will run it's important to sign up early. Each class has a minimum amount of participants needed to perform the class, and must be reached before the start of class.
2. Children meet in the lunch area to eat their lunch.
3. There will be rosters printed on the tables with your child's name. Your child must sit with the class they registered for in the lunch area. After lunch, they will be dismissed by a staff member to each of their classes.
4. Please notify school if child is absent.


