# REGISTRATION & PROGRAM DETAILS

## Four EASY ways to register!

1. **Online:** Sign up at <https://registration.fostercity.org/>
  2. **Walk-In:** Visit the Recreation Center at 650 Shell Blvd. and sign up in person M-TH from 8a-8p and Friday 8a-5p.
  3. **Mail:** Send completed registration form with Visa/MasterCard information to Recreation Center (650 Shell Blvd. Foster City, CA 94404).
  4. **Fax/E-mail:** Send completed registration form with Visa/MasterCard information. Put Attn: "Registration." (650) 286-3521 or send to [recreation@fostercity.org](mailto:recreation@fostercity.org).
- Foster City School will *not* accept registrations.
  - **All classes are held at school site.** You must register your child for classes that are held at their respective school.
  - *Spaces are on a first come, first serve basis.*
  - Waitlists are available. If a space becomes available, participants will be notified by phone/e-mail in the order of which they came in.

## Program Policies

During the Wednesday Enrichment Program, we ask that parents follow a few guidelines to make this a successful program:

1. Register *early!* To avoid cancellation of classes for your child and to guarantee the class will run, it's important to register early. Each class has a minimum amount of participants needed to perform the class, and must be reached before the start of class.
2. Some classes have a materials/lab fee. The materials/lab fee goes towards supplies that are purchased by the contractor. The check/cash must be paid directly to the instructor on the **first** day of class.
3. Please make sure you are picking your child up on time. A late fee of \$5 every 5 minutes will be enforced after 5 minutes of the class concluding, and the late fee will need to be paid on the same day.
