PROPOSAL DUE (EXTENDED): November 7, 2016 at 2:00 PM

A pre-proposal meeting was held on October 19, 2016 to address any questions from the prospective consultants regarding the Request for Proposal. This addendum provides written response to the questions raised at the pre-proposal meeting. In addition, this addendum serves as a notification to the prospective consultants that the deadline for proposals is being extended from October 31, 2016 to **November 7, 2016 at 2:00 PM**.

Q1: What are the schools included as part of the Safe Routes to School Assessment (Task 1)?

A1: *Foster City Elementary School, Brewer Island Elementary School, Audubon Elementary School, and Bowditch Middle School.*

Q2: Is the City planning to use the Bicycle Network Assessment (Task 2) as the City's Bicycle Master Plan? Or if the City is anticipating a follow-on effort to create a full Bicycle Master Plan?

A2: *The City anticipates the Bicycle Network Assessment will serve as the City's Bicycle Master Plan. The anticipated amount of effort for public engagement would be to present the draft study to the Traffic Review Committee, as well as to the City Council for comments, and adoption of the final study.*

Q3: Does the budget of ten (10) traffic signal warrant studies and five (5) stop sign warrant studies described in the Evaluation of Citizens Requests (Task 4) include the specific requests listed in Task 4?

A3: Yes.

Q4: What type of traffic signal central system does the City currently have?

A4: *Streetwise by Naztec. In addition, there are 25 signalized intersections in the City. Majority of these intersections communicate with the central system at City Hall via interconnect cables, while four of the intersections are connected to the central system either by dial-up modem or radio.*
