
Why use compost in school gardens or for landscaping?

- Improves Soil Quality
- Conserves Water
- Controls Erosion

How much compost can a school get?

- **Garden Project** - Schools that are planning a garden project are eligible to get up to **five 50-pound bags** of compost. The school must arrange for compost pick up at the Shoreway Environmental Center, 333 Shoreway Road, San Carlos.
- **Landscaping Project** - Schools planning on a landscaping project are eligible to receive up to **20 cubic yards** of compost per school year.

What is compost made from?



*RethinkWaste service area includes: Atherton, Belmont, Burlingame, East Palo Alto, Foster City, Hillsborough, Menlo Park, Redwood City, San Carlos, San Mateo, parts of San Mateo County, and the West Bay Sanitary District.

Checklist for compost delivery

- Clear delivery instructions, contact person, location, and maps are required. Once compost is delivered, it is the property of the school.
- Delivery area should be coned off or clear signage provided, and be located in a parking lot or street.
- Delivery area should be safely accessible (no overhead wires, no parked cars, etc.) for delivery truck.
- Any additional information that will make delivery smooth must be provided to RethinkWaste.
