Safe Routes to School Pledge

On October 3, we are asking students to sign a pledge that asks them to promise to:

- Stop, look left, right, and left again before I cross the street.
- Wear and buckle a bicycle helmet every time I ride my bicycle.
- Stay alert when walking and bicycling—I will watch out for all other traffic around me.
- Wear bright colors if I am walking or bicycling during the day and reflective gear at night.
- Stay 5 giant steps away from the street when I'm waiting for a bus.



Attention Parents:

I pledge to my child, to be a safety Role Model when biking, walking, and driving around bicyclists and pedestrians, leading by example.

I promise to...

- Walk on a sidewalk, if there is one. If not, I will walk on the side of the road facing traffic.
- Stay alert to traffic by keeping my eyes on the road. No texting while driving or walking.
- Cross streets using crosswalks or at intersections.
- Teach my children to stop, look left, right, and left again before crossing the street.
- · Have all family members wear and buckle a bike helmet every ride.
